## Waldorf High School Soccer Program

The soccer program will officially begin on September 9, 2014, and run until November 6, 2014. Bart Elsbach will coach the high school soccer team again this year and Angel Montenegro will be the assistant coach. Warren Palmer, as Athletic Coordinator, will arrange matches, distribute uniforms and contact the team by email for schedule changes and cancellations. **During practices and games, please contact Bart Elsbach directly on his cell phone (413) 229-2226 or Angel Montenegro at (914) 262-6985. If you have any other questions please contact Warren Palmer at the school (413) 298-3800.** 

All students are encouraged to play. Experience is not a requirement. There is a definite carry-over into the school when classmates learn to play as a team and support each other. We have a full calendar this year with at least 11 games (see dates on the school website calendar), so join the team!

**Practice:** Practices are on Mondays at the Park Street Park in Stockbridge, from 2:45 – 4:10 p.m. and Tuesdays, 1:15 - 2:45 p.m. at the soccer field at the Great Barrington Rudolf Steiner School. Practices are on Thursdays at the Steiner School soccer field, from 3:00 – 4:45 p.m. Attendance is required **ALL days, unless a student is absent from school or has made special arrangements with the coach.** Once a commitment has been made, the student is expected to participate for the duration of the program and to be available for all games. Please speak to the coach as soon as possible if you will miss practice or a game.

**Transportation:** Parents are expected to make arrangements to pick students up at the Park Street Park in Stockbridge on Mondays (We can help to find rides to the Steiner School for the Taconic late bus by 4:45 p.m.). On Tuesdays Taconic students can take the Taconic bus home at 3:00 p.m. Parents are expected to make arrangements to pick students up at the Steiner School on Thursdays at 4:45 p.m. (There is no Taconic late bus.)

Athletic Clothing: All soccer players must come to practice prepared to play in appropriate soccer attire: soccer cleats, shin guards, soccer socks, tshirts, shorts or sweatpants. Shin guards and soccer cleats are mandatory! Shin guards and soccer cleats can be purchased at Olympia Sports, Jacks and Barrington Outfitters in Great Barrington, or Reynolds Team Sales in the Allendale Shopping Center and Dick's, both in Pittsfield.

**Uniforms:** The school provides team uniforms. These uniforms are the property of the school. **Players are responsible for their uniforms. Students will be charged for uniforms NOT RETURNED at the end of the season.** 

*Physical:* Massachusetts State Law requires that any student who attends a Massachusetts school, and participates in any sports **MUST** have a physical each new school year.
